Annual Parish Meeting scheduled for May 13th is CANCELLED

In light of this guidance from Sussex and Surrey Association of Local Councils:

The Annual Parish Meeting is not a council meeting but a meeting of electors, it is only by convention that it is organised by the Parish Council. A Parish Meeting can be called by six electors at any time during the year.

The Parish Council or other electors could arrange an Annual Parish Meeting after the CORVID19 situation settles.

The Parish Clerk will make the annual accounts available as usual when they are complete. Legislation has been passed to allow a longer period than normal for the accounts to be prepared.

May Parish Council Meeting deferred until 27th May

The Parish Council Meeting for May will be held on 27th. It is hoped by then that a normal meeting will be possible and held in the Sports Pavilion. If not, a virtual meeting will be arranged, and members of the public will be able to request a login from the Parish Clerk to join the meeting.
