UPDATES:

We have had 2 reported incidents of theft. 2 were thefts of cement mixers from Mongers Mead on the 24/6 & Church Road on 30/6. We have visited many building sites across the area to make builders aware. The one other reported theft was garden furniture from the Barcombe Mills area on the 30/6. We have been following a line of enquiry regarding this.

The reported incident of criminal damage was damage to a car window in Munsters Green on the 18/6, there is no line of enquiry regarding this.

2 of the burglaries were to outbuildings in The Grange on the 11/6 & on the nature reserve on the 11/6. On both occasions tools & lawn mowers were taken. The one other burglary was an attempted burglary on the 25/6 in Weald View, we have done extensive enquires in the area but have no lines of enquiry at the moment.

Due to the increase in break ins to outbuildings in the rural area we have increased patrols in your area at key times. Please make sure you report all suspicious activity to us, including the registration of any vehicles you are suspicious of.

COMMUNITY SPEED WATCH: My colleague PcsO Knowles is at present setting up a community speed watch group in Barcombe. A number of Barcombe residents have volunteered to run this & in the next few weeks will be trained to use a speed gun. They will then be doing speed checks on the Barcombe Mills Road in the 30mph limit. Those caught speeding will be reported on Operation Crackdown & dealt with accordingly
